TranSports focuses on competitive team goals, while still allowing individuals the freedom to focus on personal goals. Team competitive goals include the USATF Club XC championships, the Pacific Association Grand Prix, and in the future may include the USATF Road Relay championship.

Standards

Standards for new members joining the team are:

- **5k:** 15:10 (M); 18:32 (W)
- **10k:** 31:59; 39:11 (W)
- **Marathon:** 2:29:40 (M); 2:57:23 (W)

Members are required to race at least 10 times per year, with at least 5 of those races being Pacific Association or other adidas-approved races.
